



**Addendum I: TO DUAL ADMISSIONS AND CORE-TO-CORE
TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
Between
COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF PHILADELPHIA
and
LA SALLE UNIVERSITY**

This Addendum to the Dual Admissions and Core-to-Core Transfer Articulation Agreement (“Addendum”), is made between Community College of Philadelphia (CCP) and La Salle University (La Salle).

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the Dual Admissions and Core-to-Core Transfer Articulation Agreement (“Agreement”) between the parties updated January 2020; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to include CCP Dual Enrollment students in the existing Agreement between CCP and La Salle;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto, for good consideration and intending to be legally bound, hereby do agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

Program Additions. The parties agree to amend the Agreement to include the Dual Enrollment students enrolled at CCP.

Dual enrollment at CCP refers to high school students who take college level courses taught by College faculty at CCP. This Addendum is intended for dual enrollment students who earn an associate degree at CCP before transfer.

Student Eligibility. To be eligible to benefit from this Addendum, dual enrollment students must have earned an appropriate associate degree and follow the terms and conditions as noted in this Addendum. Dual enrollment students who do not earn an appropriate associate degree before transfer to La Salle do not qualify for the benefits of this Addendum and are encouraged to apply to La Salle under their regular admissions process.

Under this Addendum, these CCP graduates will be guaranteed admission into a Bachelor’s degree program at La Salle on the condition that they:

- Submit an intent form before earning no more than 45 graded college level credits (grades of A, B, C, D, F) from CCP or any other college/university.
- Complete the La Salle First Year Admissions Application (not the Transfer Application).
- Submit official high school transcripts as well as official transcripts from CCP and all other institutions attended.

- Satisfy all other La Salle admissions requirements through La Salle’s normal transfer admissions process.
- Achieve a final minimum 2.5 cumulative CCP grade point average (GPA). Certain majors do require a higher GPA upon entrance to La Salle:
 - Nursing – 3.0 science and cumulative GPA (additional testing may be required)
 - Education – 3.0 cumulative GPA
 - Nutrition – 2.75 cumulative GPA
- Enroll directly to La Salle within one year of completing an associate degree program of study from CCP and not attend another institution.

Students who participate in dual enrollment opportunities at CCP and earn college level credit before they complete their high school diploma will be given the same academic benefits of any other student transferring from CCP to La Salle and as such, CCP courses will transfer to La Salle as any other transfer student. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better are transferable.

A student’s academic status will be determined by the academic program the student chooses to pursue at La Salle and the number of college level credits that transfer for that academic program by the time they enroll at La Salle.

Dual enrollment students who earn a CCP associate degree from the list of approved majors in Appendix A of the Agreement before or at the same time they earn their high school diploma will be awarded all benefits of Core-to-Core as defined in the Agreement.

Financial and Scholarship Incentives. To encourage CCP dual enrollment students to transfer to La Salle, La Salle agrees to award students transferring to La Salle the following scholarships:

- CCP dual enrollment students who earn an associate degree from the list of approved majors in Appendix A of the Agreement will be awarded an annual academic Founder’s scholarship based on their final CCP cumulative GPA.
- Students wanting to live on campus will also receive an additional partial residential scholarship.
- La Salle will also cover the cost of all books required for their classes by a professor over a period of 2 years or up to once a bachelor’s degree is awarded, whichever comes first.

Additional Program incentives: FAFSA filing workshops are available to students enrolled in any of the current Dual Enrollment Programs at CCP.


Effective Date. This Addendum shall take effect for Spring 2021 graduates although students may submit their intent form as soon as it is available during Fall 2020.

Terms of Original Agreement. All other benefits, terms and conditions of the original Agreement not modified in this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect.


Counterparts. Provided that all parties execute a copy of this Addendum, this Addendum may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same document. This Addendum may be executed by the parties and transmitted by facsimile or electronic transmission, and, if so executed and transmitted, shall be effective as if the parties had delivered an executed original of this Addendum.

Acknowledging good and valuable consideration, this Addendum is executed and delivered as of the date set forth below.


