# DUAL ADMISSIONS and CORE-TO-CORE TRANSFER AGREEMENT BETWEEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF PHILADELPHIA AND WILMINGTON UNIVERSITY

### **Preface**

Community College of Philadelphia (CCP) and Wilmington University (WilmU) enter into this Dual Admissions and Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement (Agreement) to facilitate the transfer of CCP students to WilmU. This Agreement applies to students who enter WilmU's traditional or online programs as full-time or part-time undergraduate students.

### **Dual Admissions**

Under the Dual Admissions Transfer Agreement, CCP students will be guaranteed admission into WilmU with third year (junior) status and be eligible for the renewable transfer scholarship, at WilmU on the condition that they:

- 1. Submit an electronic Dual Admissions Intent form before completion of no more than 45 college level credits from all colleges/universities attended;
- 2. Graduate from CCP with an appropriate Associate in Arts (A.A.), Associate in Science (A.S.) or Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) Degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. (Please see Appendix A for a list of degree/majors included in this Agreement);
- Complete WilmU's admissions application the semester before the student plans to matriculate to WilmU and satisfy all other regular WilmU admissions requirements which include;
  - Submit Official Transcripts from all schools attended
  - Complete the Student Conduct (Title IX) Training
  - B.S. in Nursing majors must submit a copy of RN License
- 4. Do not attend another institution of higher education between the time they graduate from CCP and enroll at WilmU;
- 5. Enroll at WilmU within one year of CCP graduation.

Students who have previously matriculated to WilmU are not eligible for Dual Admissions to WilmU, but are encouraged to apply as a transfer or readmissions student to WilmU.

There is no obligation on the part of the Dual Admissions CCP student if the student decides not to transfer to WilmU.

Once a student has submitted the electronic Dual Admissions Intent Form, he or she is strongly encouraged to meet with a WilmU Admissions Representative and/or a CCP Academic Advisor, Counselor or Program Advisor to develop a course taking strategy to maximize course transferability.

CCP graduates entering WilmU under the terms of this Agreement for both Dual Admissions and Core-to-Core go through the WilmU normal transfer admissions process and therefore must meet all applicable WilmU requirements and deadlines pertaining to application for admission, orientation and registration, and payment of tuition and fees. They will abide by the policies and procedures, and any revisions thereof that apply to all WilmU students.

### Transfer and Academic Guidelines

- 1. Transfer credit will be awarded for courses with a grade of "C" or above for any and all courses transferred to WilmU. Grades of "D" will transfer to WilmU if the student has a conferred associate degree from CCP. WilmU will need official transcripts for evaluation of credit from all institutions attended, including military transcripts. Credit will be awarded for AP, CLEP, PLA, Experiential Learning, etc. with appropriate documentation. Developmental courses are not eligible for transfer.
- 2. The maximum number of semester hours that can transfer to WilmU is 90. Students enrolled in an undergraduate program of study at WilmU are required to complete a minimum of 30 upper level credits upon transfer to WilmU.
- 3. A full-time student admitted with third year (junior) status to WilmU will be able to complete a bachelor's degree at WilmU within four regular (fall/spring) semesters provided the student completes the appropriate associate degree at CCP and completes and appropriately sequences his/her remaining course work at WilmU.
- 4. Under this Agreement, WilmU guarantees that except for developmental course credits, all CCP credits from CCP programs of study listed in this Agreement will fulfill general education, elective or major requirements in the corresponding WilmU major that the CCP transfer student wishes to pursue.
- 5. Students who have pursued a CCP associate degree study other than those designated in Appendix A of this Agreement and who wish to transfer to WilmU will be guaranteed admission on an individual basis and their credits will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis. Depending on the program of choice at WilmU, not all transfer credits may be applied to major.

# Core-to-Core

WilmU agrees to accept the General Education embedded in CCP's Associate in Arts (A.A.), Associate in Science (A.S.) and Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degrees as meeting all the requirements of its undergraduate General Education requirements.

This Core-to-Core Agreement applies to all graduates of approved CCP A.A., A.S. and A.A.S. degrees and is not limited to students who participate in Dual Admissions. Core-to-Core transfer does not alter the requirements of the student's major field of study as identified in the WilmU catalog.

## Financial and Scholarship Incentives

To encourage CCP graduates to transfer to WilmU, WilmU agrees to the following:

- 1. WilmU will waive the application fee for students who apply to WilmU pursuant to this Agreement.
- 2. All students will be provided with WilmU financial aid information and receive full consideration for WilmU financial aid upon matriculation at WilmU.
- 3. Financial Aid will be awarded to Dual Admissions students on the same basis as all WilmU students. They will have equal access to all state and federal financial aid programs.
- 4. WilmU will award a renewable academic scholarship to all CCP Dual Admissions students admitted to WilmU pursuant to the following:
  - CCP graduates will complete at least 12 credits of WilmU course-work with a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA within 12-months of enrolling in first course.
    - Students that meet the requirements above will be eligible for a renewable one course (3-credit) scholarship for a minimum of two courses and a maximum of four courses, students must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA for coursework completed at WilmU at the time each scholarship is awarded.
    - The initial one course (3-credit) scholarship will be awarded after completion of the fourth course at WilmU and will be renewable at five course intervals. For example:
      - Students with 10 courses / 30 credits remaining to complete a bachelor degree at WilmU will be eligible for a scholarship of up to 2 courses / 6 credits. Each scholarship made available for the 5<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> course enrolled in at WilmU.
      - Students with 15 courses / 45 credits remaining to complete a bachelor degree at WilmU will be eligible for a scholarship of up to 3 courses / 9 credits. Each scholarship made available for the 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> course enrolled in at WilmU.
      - Students with 20 courses / 60 credits remaining to complete a bachelor degree at WilmU will be eligible for a scholarship of up to 4 courses / 12 credits. Each scholarship made available for the 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>th</sup> course enrolled in at WilmU.
    - o Note: Student's with eligibility for a one course (3-credit) scholarship that are entering their final semester at WilmU, with no subsequent semesters of enrollment, will be awarded the final scholarship during that semester.
    - o Renewable scholarship only available for the initial bachelor degree at WilmU.

### The Agreement

To facilitate the transfer of CCP graduates to WilmU in accordance with the foregoing guarantee, the parties agree to the following:

### **Obligations of Wilmington University:**

- 1. To participate in student outreach (e.g.: transfer fairs, campus visits, virtual open houses, etc.) at least twice each fall and spring semesters.
- 2. To invite CCP students to an informational meeting with WilmU faculty and staff on a regular basis at both CCP and WilmU in order to facilitate smooth curricular and co-curricular integration to WilmU.
- 3. To send a WilmU conditional letter of acceptance to all CCP students who complete a Dual Admissions Intent form in accordance with the expectations stated in the Dual Admissions section and who meet the conditions set forth in this Agreement.
  - A formal offer of admission will be sent upon receipt of the Undergraduate Admissions application (the semester before the students plan to matriculate). CCP students who complete a Dual Admissions Intent form will be governed by the WilmU degree requirements in effect at the time of admission to WilmU or during their term of enrollment.

Students from the Philadelphia area who apply to WilmU will be encouraged to attend and earn an appropriate associate degree from CCP so as to take advantage of the benefits of this Agreement. CCP will receive a list from WilmU of students sent this letter so that they can follow up with the students.

- 4. To support Core-to-Core approved CCP A.A., A.S. or A.A.S. degrees to fulfill all WilmU General Education requirements. Eligible CCP graduates enrolling at WilmU will be identified upon admission to WilmU, and the fact that they have satisfied WilmU General Education requirements by Core-to-Core transfer will be noted on all pertinent WilmU student records. Core-to-Core transfer does not alter the requirements of the student's major field of study as identified in the WilmU catalog.
- 5. To encourage CCP transfer students to complete the appropriate associate degree before matriculation to WilmU in order to take advantage of this Agreement. If the CCP student chooses to transfer and matriculate to WilmU before completion of the associate degree, WilmU will encourage reverse transfer. WilmU will develop a reverse transfer credit process, which must be mutually agreed upon by both WilmU and CCP that includes methodology to notify and assist students with this reverse transfer benefits.
- 6. To continue working with CCP on program-to-program curriculum Transfer Guides that specify for CCP transfer students the CCP courses that satisfy major requirements needed for degree completion at WilmU. To facilitate this, CCP and WilmU agree to finalize program-to-program transfer guides by no later than 3 months from the signing of this Agreement.

### Obligations of Community College of Philadelphia

- 1. To invite students to participate in this Agreement.
- 2. To publicize this Agreement to prospective students in its promotional literature.
- 3. To make arrangements for WilmU recruiters to visit CCP.
- 4. To inform qualified students matriculating at CCP of the opportunity for Core-to-Core and Dual Admissions transfer to WilmU under the terms of this Agreement.

5. To activate and send WilmU access to reports of all students who have completed the electronic Dual Admissions Intent Form for Wilmington University. Reports are uploaded into an Argos system each month.

### Joint Obligations

- 1. To consult with each other through appropriate channels prior to implementing major changes in policy or curricula that directly affect students transferring under the terms of this Agreement, and keep each other informed of any other changes of policy or curricula that affect those students. Both WilmU and CCP will review this Agreement annually and make any changes upon mutual agreement, as needed. Such changes will become effective when both CCP and WilmU sign the revised document.
- 2. To collaborate in providing students with information and academic advising about this Agreement, WilmU's academic requirements, and the process of transferring to WilmU.
- 3. To develop and implement advertising and promotional efforts to communicate the benefits of Dual Admissions and Core-to-Core transfer.
- 4. To designate a representative or representatives who will coordinate this Agreement between the two institutions.
- 5. To exchange aggregate data annually that will contribute to the maintenance and improvement of this Agreement, enhance the transfer process, and promote effective cooperation between institutions.
- 6. To facilitate and support consultation and collaboration between their faculties related to this Agreement, General Education, degree requirements, and other academic matters.
- 7. To provide direct links between WilmU and CCP websites.
- 8. To continue their respective policies of non-discrimination in regard to sex, age, race, color, creed, national origin, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity, veteran status or any other status protected by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972, the American with Disabilities Act, or any other applicable federal, state, or local law. The parties agree to reasonably cooperate with each other in any investigation of claims of discrimination or harassment, to the extent permitted by law.

### Revision, Renewal and Termination of this Agreement

Wilmington University's Vice President of Academic Affairs and the Vice President for Academic & Student Success at Community College of Philadelphia or their designees, are responsible for identifying, and communicating to each other, changes in the policies or requirements of their respective institutions that affect this Agreement. Modifications to the terms and conditions of this Agreement may only be made by written agreement of the parties. Until such modification by mutual written agreement, the then-current terms of the Agreement shall remain in effect.

This Agreement will be in effect as of the date of its signing, for students entering WilmU on or after Fall 2021, and will continue in effect for five (5) years unless otherwise modified or terminated in accordance with this Agreement. Either institution may terminate this Agreement at any time by written notice at least one year in advance of the effective date of termination. Should

this Agreement be terminated, it is understood that students already accepted to WilmU through the effective date of termination will continue to receive the benefits articulated in this Agreement.

Provided that all parties execute a copy of this Agreement, this Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same document. This Agreement may be executed by the parties and transmitted by facsimile or electronic transmission, and, if so executed and transmitted, shall be effective as if the parties had delivered an executed original of this Agreement.

The willingness of both institutions to enter this Agreement in order to facilitate the transfer of students from CCP into WilmU, and to expand their opportunities for academic success there, is indicated by the following signatures.

The undersigned representatives of the parties, Community College of Philadelphia and Wilmington University, have executed this Agreement on the date indicated below:
