- Apply a Semester Ahead
 - Fall Start: Apply in January/February/Early March
 - Spring Start: Apply in July/August/Early September
- Apply for Graduation
 - MyCCP Account – Student Quicklinks – Graduation Application

- Dual Admissions
 - Check your Dual Intent Forms
 - MyCCP Account – MyGPS – Submit a Dual Intent Form
- Transfer Agreements
 - MyCCP Account - MyGPS
- Questions
 - Contact their Admissions Office

APPLICATION PROCESS: STEP I

- Applying to the Schools
 - Dual Admissions
 - There's an area on the application to indicate that you're doing Dual Admissions and waive your application fee
 - Transfer Application
 - Transfer Agreements – Regular Application Process

APPLICATION PROCESS: STEP I

- Common App
 - College Reports
 - Dean's Certifications, Discipline Records, Academic Standing, etc.
 - Email: transforms@ccp.edu
 - Complete the student portion and **sign** your name on the form
 - Include your J number and the email address for the schools that you're applying to
 - Once completed, the forms are sent directly to the schools
 - Mid-Term Reports

APPLICATION PROCESS: STEP I

- Letters of Recommendations
 - Who should you ask?
 - Professors, former teachers, employers, coaches, community leaders, etc.
 - They should be able to give full details of your accomplishments
 - How much notice should you give?
 - At least 2-3 weeks notice

APPLICATION PROCESS: STEP II

- Request Transcripts
 - CCP
 - <https://www.myccp.online/records-and-registration/transcripts>
 - Other Colleges/Institutions
 - From their Website
 - High School
 - Not common
