1. Approval of Minutes of May 27, 2010

The Committee members reviewed the minutes; K. Harter motioned to accept the minutes, and M. McGorry seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved.

2. Old Business

There was no old business to discuss.

<u>Proposal for Revision of Management of Computer Information Technology Associate in Arts Degree Program</u>

M. McGorry introduced the program revision. The CIS 104 course was eliminated because the course was considered outdated; CIS 104 was replaced by CIS 105, which is current. Any College programs that included the CIS 104 course have replaced CIS 104 with CIS 105. The MCIT program is the last program at the College to remove CIS 104 from the curriculum. The CIS 104 course was three (3) credits and CIS 105 is four (4) credits. Replacing CIS 104 with CIS 105 increases the minimum number of credits to complete the MCIT program to 63. C. Esposito motioned to accept the document; R. McAndrew seconded the motion. The proposal was unanimously approved.
