This is to inform you that I have taken the following actions on recommendations made to me by the Institution-Wide Committee fall 2009:

- Approved the proposal for revisions to the Dental Hygiene Program, effective fall 2010:
  - 1. Clinical hours increased from 3 to 6;
  - 2. Number of DH 192 Credits decrease from 4 to 3;
  - 3. Total Number of Credits needed to graduate decrease by 1.
- Approved the proposal for revision of the Chemical Technology Program, effective fall 2010:
  - 1. Eliminated Chemistry 213 and 217;
  - 2. Added Introduction to Process Technology, PTEC 101 and Quality Control/Quality Assurance, ASET 130;
  - 3. Added ASET 110, Safety, Health and the Environment, as an alternative to Chemistry 201.
