College Policies and Procedures No. 156

To ensure the safety of children, those under the age of 16 must not be left unattended on college property. To prevent disruption of the learning process, children are not permitted in classrooms or laboratories when classes are in session. With regard to classrooms (but not laboratories), faculty members instructing a class may make exceptions in individual cases provided that the learning process is not disrupted.

Under no circumstances are minors allowed in the gymnasium, instructional laboratories, laboratory prep areas, or administrative service areas (e.g., duplicating, mail room, craft shops, library).

The College assumes no liability for any injury incurred by minors who are not registered Community College of Philadelphia students while they are on college property.

NOTE: This policy does not preclude children's participation in events sanctioned by the College or the involvement of children in educational activities specific to a curriculum.
