SUBJECT: Institution-Wide Committee Decisions

This is to inform you that I have taken the following actions on a recommendation made to me by the Institution-Wide Committee Fall 2018:

- 1) Approved the revisions to the Diagnostic Medical Imaging Program as follows:
 - a) The number of credits in the program changed from 76 to 73.
 - b) The Student Learning Outcome “practice/apply appropriate radiation protection of patients, themselves and others” was changed to delete the word practice.
 - c) The Student Learning Outcome “Demonstrate logical image screening for patients with multiple exams” was changed to “Demonstrate the ability to perform non-routine procedures.”
 - d) A Learning Outcome to “Demonstrate professional characteristics in the clinical education setting” was added.
- 2) Approved the revisions to the Justice Program as follows:
 - a) Change the name of the program to Criminal Justice.
 - b) Require a new course, JUS 131: Technology in Criminal Justice.
 - c) Add Digital Forensics courses 101 and 201 as electives.
 - d) Remove Justice 251, 221, 105, and 261 as required courses and replace them with a set of criminal justice electives.
 - e) In the third and fourth semesters include options in addition to the two-course foreign language series.
 - f) Remove CIS 103.
