SUBJECT: Institution-Wide Committee Decisions

I have received the minutes of the November 25, 2019 and February 20, 2020 Institution-Wide Committee meetings, and have taken the following actions:

- I. Approved the proposed revision to the Art and Design Degree Program, as follows:
 - (a) Remove CIS 103 and replace with Art 150 and Art 290, which meet the general education technological competency.
 - (b) Make Art 205 a required course. The course has been re-written and is now called Modern & Contemporary Art instead of Modern American Art.
 - (c) Include ART 171/172/173: Topics in Art and ART 180/182/183: Topics in Art Studio as Directed Elective Options.
 - (d) PUT English 102 earlier in the course sequence.
- II. Approved the proposed revisions to the Computer Science Degree Program, as follows:
 - (a) Revise CIS 205, CSCI 111, CSCI 112, CSCI 211, CSCI 213. The revisions primarily change course-learning outcomes to better align with the TAOC agreement, and change the prerequisite for CSCI 213 to CSCI 111 with a grade of C or better and MATH 163.
 - (b) Add ENGL 115: Public Speaking as a required course instead of as a humanities option.
 - (c) Replace MATH 251 with CSCI 218: Statistics for Computing and Data Science.
 - (d) Change the math entry requirement from MATH 161 to MATH 162.
 - (e) Eliminate reference to developmental course work.
 - (f) Require that students earn a C or better in all courses.
 - (g) Increase credits from 61 to 65.

Please convey my appreciation to the members of the Institution-Wide Committee for their work on behalf of the College.
