- 1. It was reiterated that Ron Jackson and Larry MacKenzie will co-chair. They will take turns chairing meetings. Today's meeting was chaired by Ron Jackson.
- 2. Approval of minutes:
 - a. Ellie Cunningham moved to approve the minutes from September 23, 2009. Seconded: Larry MacKenzie
 - b. The motion passed.

3. Old Business:

- a. P&P 156 Revision
 - i. Ron Jackson printed from online a copy of P&P 156 as well as our revised draft from 04-22-09.
 - ii. Revisions were placed in bold and highlighted.
 - iii. We discussed possible issues that may arise before sending this onto IWC.
 - iv. We, in the past, looked at other institutions' policies, as well as when incidents occurred in violation of these polices

- v. The committee discussed improvements that were needed in the language of the committee's proposed new version of P & P 156, to avoid ambiguities and discrepancies. For example, we refer to children under 16, but the heading retains the language "dependents under the age of 18."
- vi. Ron Jackson moved to keep "dependents under the age of 18" as the heading for the policy and to change the age of 16 in our draft to 18.
 - 1. Larry MacKenzie seconded the motion.
 - 2. 5 members approved with 2 abstentions.
 - 3. The motion passed.

vii. Larry MacKenzie moved to change the placement of a sentence, so that it would be seen as applying to all children, not just the children of employees. He accepted some 'friendly amendments' made by other members of the committee.

- vii. Ron Jackson then moved to amend the motion and Phil Pollock seconded to emphasize "students' children" as opposed to just "children" in point 2 of the policy.
 - 1. 3 members approved, 4 members opposed, and 1 member abstained
 - 2. The amendment did not pass.

vii. The motion to approve the changes to the document, as amended, passed. Committee members reviewed our rationale for the proposed revision of P & P 156. Ron Jackson agreed to produce a clean version of our P & P 156 proposal as amended. Larry MacKenzie agreed to write a statement explaining the committee's rationale for the changed policy, to accompany the proposal as it is provided to the IWC.

4. New Business:

- a. P&P Memorandum No. 5.
 - i. A copy of this policy was passed out to members as we will discuss it at our next meeting.

5. Adjournment
