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- I. **Call to Order**
Meeting called to order at 2:35PM
- II. **Attendance**

- III. **Approval of minutes (Action)**
 - a. Approval of April 2012 minutes. The April draft-Minutes are located in the Files area of the MyCCP TCC group.
April 2012 Minutes – Motion-Second-Unanimous Approval
- IV. **Old Business**
 - a. **Course Conversion document (S. Jones)**
Steve Jones opened this discussion by describing the concerns around the preservation of teaching – course objectives originate from the department.
Committee addressed the Instructive Process.
Conclusions: All “must” statement should be in the P&P while all “how to” statements should reside in the Guidelines for DE
A draft of the revised P&P 14 was produced for review by the committee.
A suggestion was made to add definitions within the P&P document. Is “Course” a set of educational objectives or a set of material used in a conversion to DE.
Peter Margolis stated that this is not a course in the typical sense. Online learning systems provide online classroom space.
Steve Jones stated that for the purposes of this document, a “distance education course”, is a set of materials and interactions applied to teaching and an institutional approved course either predominately or entirely via the Internet and a course management system (CMS).

The discussion digressed into a technical issue around the Search for Available Courses and the Hybrid notation. SK Calkins will review issue.

Back to P&P 14 discussion – It was suggested that we use LMS and not CMS. Peter Margolis stated that because a course exists does not mean that it can be online.

Karen Schermerhorn disagreed that the word "class" could substitute for the word "course," since she believes a class is a group of students, whereas a "course" is a document including educational objectives, sample assignments, etc. "

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**It was decided to leave the title and definition for now.
It was decided that the sub-committee will revise the document.**
