## **CCP College Placement Assessment- Dual Enrollment**

The purpose of student placement at CCP in English and Math is to place students in courses most appropriate to their level of preparation. Placement can be satisfied by one of methods listed below. Placement for dual enrollment students differs slightly from the college's general student population, If you are not able to satisfy placement through one of these options, you will need to take a placement test.

High school seniors are evaluated using HS transcript, GPA and/or SAT/ACT/Keystone scores. High school juniors are evaluated using HS transcript, GPA and PSAT scores.
