Revised Placement Testing for Summer and Fall 2020 terms – Dual Enrollment

The process of placing new students in courses at the College has been revised for the summer/fall 2020 and spring 2021 semesters to use the high school transcript, GPA and/or SAT/ACT scores. Dual Enrollment students who are rising juniors and seniors will be assessed in this manner.

High school seniors are evaluated using HS transcript, GPA and/or SAT/ACT scores. High school juniors are evaluated using HS transcript, GPA and PSAT scores (or SAT/ACT).

Below are the placement revisions for new students entering in the summer/fall 2020 and Spring 2021 semesters:

HS GPA from 2.75 to 2.89	Developmental (Level 2)	English 098 and English 099
HS GPA from 2.9 to 3.19	College-level (Level 4)	English 098 and English 101
HS GPA of 3.2 and above OR *SAT of 560 or higher in English OR *ACT of 21 or higher in English	College-level (Level 6)	English 101

**SAT and ACT scores must be from within the last 5 years.*

Math Placement

Eligibility Criteria	Level	Course(s) Placement
HS GPA of 2.89 and below	Developmental	FNMT 016 (Arithmetic) or FNMT 019 (Introductory Mathematics)
HS GPA from 2.9 to 3.04	Developmental	FNMT 017 (Elementary Algebra)
HS GPA from 3.05 to 3.29 OR *SAT of 510 or higher in math OR *ACT of 17 or higher in math	College-level	FNMT 118 (Intermediate Algebra)
**HS GPA of 3.3 and higher with a C or higher in Algebra II or higher level math	College-level	MATH 161 (Pre-Calculus)
**HS GPA or 3.5 and higher with a C or higher in Trigonometry or Calculus	College-level	MATH 171 (Calculus I)

**SAT and ACT scores must be from within the last 5 years.*

***If no Algebra II or higher level math (for MATH 161) and no Trigonometry or Calculus (for MATH 171), default placement is FNMT 118*

All applicants with a HS GPA of 2.74 and below will take the ACCUPLACER test via remote proctoring (ZOOM) for placement.
